



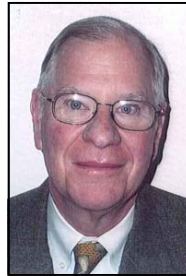
Annual Parish Celebration: Sunday, March 8, 2009 ~ MacColl Auditorium

The Vestry

The Vestry is the governing body of Saint Thomas' Church. With the clergy, the Vestry leads the parish by:

- ✦ helping to discern the vision toward which God is drawing that particular community;
- ✦ articulating and communicating the vision;
- ✦ holding the community accountable for its realization of that vision;
- ✦ keeping the mission of the Church and that of the individual congregation clearly before the parish community;
- ✦ overseeing the church's finances and property.

Current Vestry Members

The Rector, the Rector's Warden, the Accounting Warden, the Junior Warden, the Vestry Clerk and eight additional members make up the Vestry. The members of the Vestry are elected by the parish at the Annual Celebration. The Rector's Warden is appointed by the Rector. The Accounting and Junior Wardens and the Clerk are elected by the Vestry. Vestry members are elected to three-year terms of office, except when elected to fill an unexpired term of another Vestry member.
